- 1. The club is affiliated with the VPFA Ltd and all Victorian resident exhibitors must be financial members of the VPFA Ltd.
- 2. The show will be held under the VPFA Ltd Rules and Regulations
- 3. The club reserves the right to refuse entries from any person or persons without assigning a reason.
- 4. The Club will not be held responsible for any mistakes, accidents, loss or damage of any kind or from any cause though the greatest care will be taken.
- 5. Any exhibit found or believed to be sick or suffering from a disease shall be removed from the show.
- 6. Any person judged by the committee to be found guilty of causing an annoyance by loud comments on the decision of a judge, or insulting or of unseemly behaviour shall be liable to expulsion from the show, and his or her exhibits may be ordered to be removed from the show. The Committee's decision in any such case is final.
- 7. Judging sticks are not to be used by exhibitors, and birds are not to be handled once they are penned.
- 8. In the event of the advertised judge or judges being unable to attend to unforeseen circumstances, the Club reserves the right to select an alternative judge or judges to adjudicate.
- 9. The judges may withhold a prize if they consider the quality of the exhibit is of insufficient merit to warrant an award.
- 10. All judging areas must be kept clear during judging.
- 11. Exhibits will be judged to the Australian Poultry Standards Second Edition.
- 12. All birds must be penned by the time stated on the schedule. No birds will be permitted to be penned after judging has commenced.
- 13. The pavilion will be opened at 8:00am on the day of the show.
- 14. Birds may be fed a minimal amount prior to judging however all food must be removed from the pen prior to the commencement of judging.
- 15. Leg rings are permissible as long as they do not have any identifying features.
- 16. Water containers for land-fowl are provided by the club however exhibitors of other than land-fowl are to provide their own water containers.
- 17. All birds entered in the young bird classes must be under twelve months of age.
- 18. Junior members (A Junior shall be a person aged from 6years and who has not had a sixteenth birthday at either the date of applying for registration as an exhibitor or in the case of renewal of registration, the first day of January in the year in which registration fees are due and payable) who show in junior classes are only eligible for junior awards.
- 19. A Junior shall not be eligible to enter a Junior class if he or she lives at the same address as a senior registered exhibitor unless he or she exhibits a different variety to the senior exhibitor.
- 20. Junior exhibitors must pen their own exhibits on the day of the show.
- 21. Class numbers listed in the schedule are the same for juniors and seniors except juniors must include the letter "J" before the class number when completing the entry form.
- 22. Juniors and Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times when participating in or attending events conducted by the Colac Poultry Club Inc.
- 23. Persons entering this show accept that photos of exhibitors and exhibits and details of awards may be published in articles pertaining to shows or other events conducted by the Club. Please advise the Club in writing if this practise is unacceptable to you.
- 24. These Regulations are to be strictly adhered to unless changed or varied at the sole discretion of the Club Committee.
