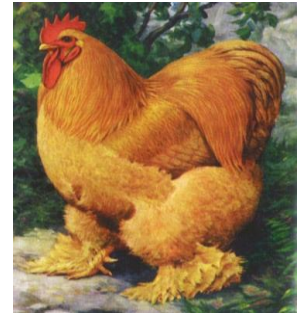

1. All exhibits must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor.
2. All champions must be from first prize winners, with the exception of the reserve.
3. Leg rings may be worn if no identifying marks on rings.
4. Although the greatest care will be taken, the Euroa & District Poultry Club will not be responsible for and mistake, loss, injury, or damage from any cause what-so-ever.
5. The committee reserves the right to reject any entry **under the Rules and regulations of the VPFA rule 33** and relocate any judge if necessary due to availability & numbers.
6. Any person causing annoyance by comments on the judge's decision, or of insulting or unseemly behaviour, shall be liable to expulsion from the show and exhibits and/or awards disqualified.
7. No person is permitted to handle or interfere with exhibits except for the judges and the stewards once judging has commenced.
8. Exhibits must be penned by 9am on the day of the show (judging 9.30am)

10. A.O.R.V. Any other recognised variety, A.O.R.C. any other recognised colour, O.E.G. Old English Game, A.O.V. classes – (please state breed).
11. Breakfast and light luncheon available at moderate cost.
12. Exhibits will be judged to the approved standard APS2 and APS addendum.
13. Donors can compete, but not win their own awards.
14. A junior member shall be a person 6-16 years. They must handle their own exhibits on the day of the show unless prior arrangement with the show manager. Juniors may exhibit in senior or junior sections but not in both. Juniors showing in senior classes must pay senior entry fees.
15. A junior exhibitor cannot show the same breed as a senior exhibitor from the same address.
16. The committee reserves the right to change, or add to, the judge's panel due to non-attendance of judges and/or excessive entries.

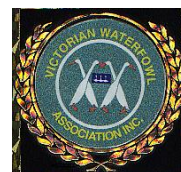

- A Novice exhibitor is eligible if you have not won a major award at a PSBEV affiliated Poultry Club Show.
- All other rules are covered in General Section of Show Schedule and are relevant for the Novice Section.
- Judging Novice, Eggs, decorated eggs and colouring competition at 10.30am with a 11.30am presentation.
