Echuca and District Poultry Club Rules

Rules and regulations

1. All entries must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor at least 14 (fourteen) days prior to the show. And must be accompanied by full entry fee.
2. The Show Manager may have an exhibit removed, which appears sick or showing sign of any wounds or disease.
3. The club will not be responsible for any mistakes, accidents, loss, or damage, although the greatest care will be taken.
4. Any person who has been judged by the committee to be guilty of causing anyone annoyance or insulting behaviour shall be liable to expulsion from the Show and his or her exhibits may be ordered to be removed and all monies and trophies forfeited.
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry with written explanation under the Rule and Regulations of the VPFA Rule 33.
6. Exhibits are not to be removed from the poultry pavilion unless permission is obtained from the President.
7. "Cockerel" and "Pullet" are birds UNDER 12 months of age.
8. All birds are entered at the owner's risk from the time they leave their hands.
9. The committee reserves the right to appoint another judge, or judges, if necessary.
10. The Judges decision SHALL BE FINAL
11. Cheques to be made out to Echuca & District Poultry Club

12. Victorian exhibitors must be members of the VPFA, for more info please go to vpfa.com.au
13. Where "A.O.R.C." or "A.O.R.V." classes are entered, please state the colour or breed on the entry form. If six (6) or more birds are entered in these classes and are of the same colour or breed a new class will be created for them.
14. If a junior exhibitor is living with a parent or guardian who also shows poultry, the junior must not show the same breed or variety as the parent or guardian.
15. All junior class exhibits must be prepared and penned by the junior exhibitor only.
16. Juniors cannot enter birds in both junior and senior classes. Juniors entering junior classes are eligible for junior awards only.
17. Junior class entries are to use the same schedule of classes as open, but to place a "J" in front of the number.
18. All birds to be judged to the Australian Poultry Standards, Edition 2, and Addendum.

Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their exhibits for the duration of the show.
