
Avian Influenza Routes of transmission





Avian Influenza (AI) is a highly contagious viral disease primarily of avian species. Waterfowl are a natural AI host and can transmit the virus without showing any symptoms. AI can be spread rapidly by close contact between birds or bird faeces, movements of contaminated people, equipment, water, feed, bedding and vehicles.
