

#### Vale Doris Loats (July 1943 – April 2025)

Doris Loates will be remembered not just as a devoted family woman and lifelong animal lover, but as a pillar of the poultry and waterfowl communities in Geelong and beyond. Her dedication, warmth, and knowledge has left a lasting legacy, one that continues to shape the hobby and passion of poultry breeding today.

Doris served the Geelong and District Poultry Club Inc. with distinction—first as Treasurer from 1997 to 2004, and later as Secretary from 2008 to 2020. Beyond administrative roles, she was a hands-on mentor to both junior and senior members, always ready



to give guidance, encouragement, and her trademark generous spirit. Her displays at Iversons Stockfeeds were well-known among locals—not only for the quality of her birds but for the expert advice she freely gave to newcomers and seasoned breeders alike.

Her influence extended further as a respected member of the Victorian Waterfowl Association and a judge of considerable repute. Doris judged Waterfowl and Turkeys at the prestigious Royal Melbourne Show in 2008, a testament to her expertise and deep understanding of poultry standards. She also served on the VPFA (Victorian Poultry Fanciers Association) board, continuing to advocate for education and excellence in breeding.

Doris's passion was perhaps most evident in her love of Indian Runner Ducks, though over the years she kept and bred a wide variety of ducks and chooks. In a 2007 interview with the Victorian Waterfowl Association's magazine, Doris fondly recalled her beginnings: "I had a pet duck as a child and have always liked them. I joined the Geelong Poultry Club and showed Sussex, then was given a pair of Indian Runners from Tasmania. I hatched eighteen ducklings and started showing ducks." Her approach to showing was thoughtful and humble—valuing feedback from various judges, always striving to improve her lines, and appreciating the camaraderie that poultry shows offered. "It's a challenge for myself," she said.

Outside the poultry sheds, Doris's life was equally rich. She was deeply involved in her granddaughter's equestrian interests and was always ready to lend a hand—whether it was for family, friends, or the wider community.

Doris paved the way for many in the fancy. Her strong lines of birds are still held in high regard, and her legacy continues in the passion and knowledge she passed on to others. The poultry community—and all who knew her—are better for her presence.

Our deepest condolences go out to her family.

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### Please Read Carefully

- 1. All entries are received subject to the rules and regulations of this society and the V.P.F.A. Ltd.
- 2. All Victorian exhibitors must be financial members of the V.P.F.A. Ltd
- 3. Pen numbers will not be returned, and can be collected from the Show Secretary or Show Manager on the morning of the show.
- 4. All exhibits must be penned by 9.15 a.m. as judging will commence at 9.30 a.m. sharp.
- 5. No exhibit will be handled by the owner or any other unauthorized person once judging has commenced.
- 6. The society will not be responsible for any mistake, accident, loss or damage whatever the cause, although the greatest care will be taken.
- 7. All entries must be accompanied by the full entry fee and **NO late entries will be accepted**.
- 8. All cheques and money orders must be made out to Geelong and District Poultry club Inc.
- 9. Any exhibitor wishing to change or add to their entry on the day of show, will be charged double entry fees per change or addition.
- 10. The Committee reserves the right to change or add to, the judge's panel due to non-attendance of judges or excessive entries.
- 11. Any exhibit entered in the wrong class will be disqualified from the show and any bird suffering from a contagious disease will be removed from the pavilion and entry fees forfeited.
- 12. It shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor to remove any feed or water utensils from their pens prior to judging commencing.
- 13. Leg bands, as long as non-identifying, are permitted at this show.
- 14. Judges shall be the only persons using judging sticks on the birds any person found guilty of causing annoyance by loud comments on the work of the judges, or of insulting or unseemly behaviour, shall be liable to expulsion from the show and his /her exhibits will be disqualified and all prizes and entry fees will be forfeited.
- 15. A junior shall be between the ages of 5 and 16 on the day of the show.
- 16. Exhibitors in the junior section will only be eligible for prizes in the junior section.
- 17. A junior exhibiting in the junior section, must exhibit a different breed or variety to a senior residing at the same address
- 18. Juniors are able to show in either senior section OR junior section not both.
- 19. Any senior found helping a junior within the surrounds of the poultry pavilion, will have his/ her exhibits disqualified unless prior permission is obtained from the Show Manager.
- 20. Please fill in both sides of the entry form, entries will only be excepted via email or Australia post using a standard entry for located on the V.P.F.A website
- 21. Where six or more birds are entered in a class, a best of breed sash will be awarded.
- 22. When entering A.O.R.C., A.R.V., A.O.R.V. classes, please specify breed variety or colour.
- 23. Juniors when entering junior classes, place the letter "J" in front of class number.

- 24. All birds will be judged to the Australian poultry standards, edition 2 and addendums.
- 25.
