Rules & Regulations.

- 1) All entries close on Monday 25th of May 2026 or when shed is full.
- 2) This Show is conducted under the VPFA Ltd Rules & Regulations.
All Exhibitors must be members of The Game Club of Victoria.
- 3) All Victorian Exhibitors are to hold a current VPFA membership for details go to www.vpfa.com.au or Secretary, Anne Beaty @ admin@vpfa.com.au or hold a C class membership with the Game Club nominated as one of your clubs.
- 4) All birds must be penned by 9.00 A.M. as judging starts at 9.15 AM. Sharp. Birds not penned by this time will not be judged.
- 5) No bird is to be removed from the show without the permission of the Show Manager or their Assistants.
- 6) All Exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to the show.
- 7) Exhibits entered in the wrong class will be disqualified from competition, except for Junior exhibits.
- 8) Exhibits suffering from a contagious disease will be removed from the pavilion and entry fees forfeited.
- 9) The greatest care will be taken with all exhibits, but The Game Club will NOT be responsible for any loss, damage or accident from whatever arises.
- 10) The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries under Item 33 VPFA Rules and Regulations.
- 11) Any person caught insulting or interfering with the Judge, while judging is in progress will be subject to removal from the Pavilion, and any prizes awarded to them will be forfeited.
- 12) The use of judging sticks by exhibitors will NOT be allowed.
- 13) Leg bands are not permitted on birds.
- 14) Exhibitors showing in Any Other Colour or Any Other Variety Classes, please state Colour or Variety on your entry forms, as SIX (6) or more will constitute a separate class.
- 15) Best of breed sash where there are 8 or more in a class.
